

# Korea BIO Industry

\*\* Based on the bioindustry classification code [KS J 1009], which has been established and revised as the standard for the scope and definition of the Korea bioindustry, an annual complete enumeration survey is planned to be conducted among companies that do research and development or produce products and services based on biotechnology.




As of 2021, there are 1,055 bio companies in South Korea; as for bio-related sites (in order of factories > research centers > headquarters), 350 sites are located in Gyeonggi-do and 249 in Seoul, indicating that the majority of them are distributed in the Seoul/Gyeonggi area.



# Manpower

As of 2021, the number of employees working in 1,055 Korea biotechs is 55,618, which represents an increase of 3,321 compared to that in 2020.

- Bioindustry manpower consists of 17,908 (32.2%) research personnel, 17,867 production personnel (32.1%), and 19,843 (35.7%) other personnel, who are involved in sales and management.







# **Supply and Demand Status**

The total size of the supply and demand for the domestic bioindustry in 2021 was KRW 25,767.6 billion, an increase of KRW 6,138.7 billion (31.3%) from the previous year. The sales amounted to KRW 20,998.3 billion (81.5%), and the imports amounted to KRW 4,769.2 billion (18.5%).

The domestic market size was KRW 13,907.7 billion (54.0%), and the exports amounted to KRW 11,859.9 billion (46.0%).


